CHAMPION OF THE INDUSTRY AWARD

The *Champion of the Industry Award* honours individuals who have made an outstanding contribution to the Australian cider industry over a prolonged period of time.

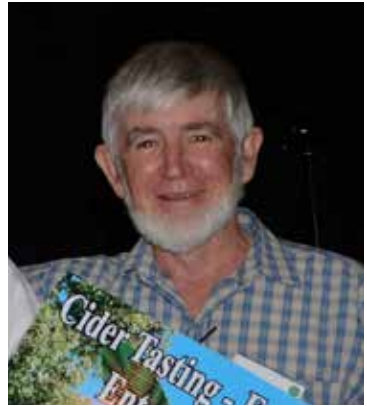
Cider Australia is proud to award the second *Champion of the Industry Award* to David Pickering, a researcher and apple orchardist from Huntley in the central west of NSW. He is a highly regarded expert on cider apples with a passion for researching, educating and connecting the industry.

David's travels to England in 1972 ignited his interest in cider. He planted an orchard at his property in the early 1980s, trialling a dozen cider apple varieties. Subsequent trips overseas led David to investigate the prospects of growing more English and French varieties and tracking down every single cider apple variety grown in Australia!

David saw the potential of cider well before it became popular in Australia – as a researcher at the NSW Department of Industries, and in his own work. He set up the website *CiderOz - A development guide to Cider Apples in Australia*, a unique resource that has helped and guided so many current and prospective cider apple growers.

David established the Australian Cider Awards in 2011 alongside Gail Kendell, after attending earlier national cider competitions held in South Australia from 2007. He continues to be an important contributor on the Awards organising team. David was also instrumental in setting up Cider Australia with James Kendell in 2013.

David has spoken to and advised so many Australian growers and cider producers. His thoughtful, persistent and committed approach is valued and commands respect from the cider community in Australia and internationally.
